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
The authors noticed an accidental calculation error existing in Fig. 4C of the original article [1]. The given velocities of the GAT-1 transporter (in this figure only) were mistakenly listed as 50-fold too high. Based on

the correct values (Fig. 1), the new estimate of  $V_{\max}$  for GAT-1 is  $0.256 \pm 0.007 \text{ nmol min}^{-1} \text{ mg protein}^{-1}$ . This change will in no manner affect the conclusions/narrative of the experiments as described in the original publication. The authors apologize for any inconvenience caused.
